Read: Mathew 11:25-30

Discussion:

- 1. Upon what or whom is Jesus' authority based? What other verses do you know that establish this? See also John 3:35, Ephesians 1:22-23, Phil 2:5-11.
- 2. A yoke is a wooden bar that is fitted to one or two animals to enable them to pull a load. How can a yoke, which is made for work, give you rest?
- 3. What makes a yoke uneasy? Where have you experienced difficulty because of an uneasy yoke?
- 4. To what or whom are you yoked? Are you pulling with Jesus or against him?

Application: Think about work and rest in your life. Ask God what he wants you to know about work and rest.

Prayer: Father God, only in you can we find our true work and our true rest. We ask you to teach us and guide us. Amen.
