Review: What did you Pastor Aaron's sermon on Christ the King Sunday inspire you to do?

Read: Luke 1:26-38.

Discussion:

- 1. Is there a difference in Gabriel's greeting between "you are highly favored" and "the Lord is with you"? Similarities?
- 2. How did Gabriel respond to Mary being greatly troubled?
- 3. Why did Gabriel provide Mary with the details of Jesus's mission and rule?
- 4. Reflect on the question of Mary (verse 34) and Gabriel's answer. Was this a lack of faith on Mary's part? Different than the response of Zechariah? Explain.
- 5. What is your reaction/thoughts on Mary's commitment to what God has planned?

Application: Believe this week that there is nothing impossible with God, for you, for others and the world.
