3. Where are we mentioned in these scriptures? What is our connection to Jesus and his work?
4. Where do you need Jesus to do his reconciling work in your life? Where have you seen Jesus bring people into alignment with God?
5. How do you respond to the lordship of Jesus?

Application: Write a poem or song of praise to King Jesus.
