Remembering the Vanishing Jesus

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Luke 24:28-35

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Introduction:

This year we have been asking. "What does it mean to live my life with Christ at the center?" We are looking at the Gospels to see how many faithful men and women centered their lives on Jesus. As we consider their lives, we can take a look at our own lives to pose the questions "On what is my life centered?" and "Where does Jesus fit in my life?".

Read: Luke 24:28-35

Prayer: Holy God, you have all wisdom. We do not. We depend on you to show us what you want us to know. Amen.

Discussion:

1. What reasons would these disciples have to urge Jesus to stay with them? See Luke 24:25-27 and 24:32
2. What made them know that it was Jesus who was with them? Why was this a good proof for them?
3. What do these disciples do right after this experience? How does God add to their confidence?
4. How does God make Himself known to you? What ways are personal to you that might not make sense to someone else?
5. How does what you are learning about Jesus help you to make sense of things that have happened in the past?

Application: Look to see how God shows himself to you. Who could you share that with?

Prayer: Father, thank you for your tender care of us. You meet us where we are and bring us closer to you to know you better. May our eyes be opened to see you. Amen
